



2008 Adagio Rutherford, Napa Valley

Our Pedemonte Cellars wines come from the Rutherford Appellation of the Napa Valley. For the last 20 years, our winemakers have tended this prestigious vineyard, meticulously selecting specific rows in separate blocks, and then cultivating each differently to encourage the best from each wine. Our wine has been nurtured from the vine to the bottle by the same caring hands, and we strive to let each vintage be an expression of the exceptional Rutherford fruit from which it derives.

Tasting Notes:

This is our proprietary blend of Sangiovese, Syrah and Cabernet that is crafted to be enjoyed early, spending just a few months in oak barrels. The fruit is sourced from the same Rutherford vineyard as our Cabernet Sauvignon.

A perfectly balanced blend. Medium to full bodied with concentrated fresh wild berry and sweet tea tannins that give way to an elegantly broad mid palate and a pleasingly long fruit finish.

Vineyards:

Our fruit comes from the beautiful Round Pond Estate vineyards. Each row has been selected and meticulously tended to by our winemaker to insure that each vine produces the highest quality fruit showing the unique, alluvial Rutherford soils that resulted from the changing path of Conn Creek and the Napa River over the last several thousand years.
